Goal Setting Methodology**

TACK has established a Proposed Overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goal of 0.45% for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2018 – 2020. The DBE Goal is applicable to DOT (FTA) assisted contracting opportunities scheduled to be awarded during the period of October 1, 2017 through September 2020. TACK's Proposed Overall DBE Goal and its rationale (developed in response to U.S. Department of Transportation's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program Regulations published under Title 49 CFR Part 26) are posted on the TACK website at [www.tacktransit.org](http://www.tacktransit.org) and is available for inspection for thirty (30) days following the date of this Notice, from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm, Eastern Time, Monday through Friday at TACK located at:
